

BELIZE COASTAL HIGHWAY UPGRADE

- US\$36.6 million loan; GBP25 million grant
- Improve climate resilience
- Increase connectivity between north and south of Belize
- Reduce travel time
- Improve access to services
- Boost economic development

BELIZE SECOND ROAD SAFETY PROJECT

- US\$5.9 million loan
- Belize has the highest road fatality rate of CDB's 19 BMCs – 21 per 100,000 people
- Increasing awareness and understanding of risks
- Improve traffic law enforcement and post-crash response

JAMAICA AGRICULTURAL PROJECT

- O GBP 974,000 grant
- Prepare a feasibility and design study for development of project in St. Catherine and Clarendon
- Boost capacity for designs and plans for a project to include an irrigation system and production and marketing systems




